

German or Bilingual


Learning German: understanding words, distinguishing terms, assigning them and using them correctly. Experimenting with sounds and words, playing, experiencing the rhythm of language.

Kimby's Methods Early Language Development: Kimby's German modules for early language development:



Whole group: morning and afternoon circle with repeated rituals, movement songs, counting rhymes, circle games, weather wheel, month wheel, calendar, office schedule, Punch and Judy show, story time....



Small groups/individual support: age-appropriate play and learning stations (guided sequences) with pedagogical teaching aids (picture and symbol cards, various table, floor and movement games, ...)



Whole group: free play zones for socialisation (role play, reading corner, construction games...)



Playful learning with stations: alternating learning in sitting & standing, loud & quiet, alone or together, spatial orientation, autonomy
